- HELD AT:** Trenton Township Maintenance and Office Building, 15495 Hartford Road, Sunbury, OH 43074
- ROLL CALL:** Chairman Almendinger called meeting to order. Roll Call: Richard Fisher -here, Kevin Justice – here, and Mark Almendinger – here.
- MINUTES:** Fiscal Officer read minutes of April 3, 2024, meeting.

- MANAGEMENT REPORT:** Trustees signed Management Report dated May 1, 2024
- TRASH DAYS:** Fisher reported that he had lined up 2 steel dumpsters and tire recycling a 30-40 yard dumpster. Almendinger has lined up Rumpke. We have vouchers for 15 ton at \$30 a ton.
- BSTG FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Fisher reported that plans have been submitted for new building. Bid will happen in Sept/Oct. There will be no bi-fold doors. They are waiting on Nationwide regarding land. The road to stub off roadway has not been completed.
- ZONING INSPECTOR REPORT:** Dattilo reported that he has attended Township, DRPC and BZA Meetings. He issued two Zoning Certificates. He is not getting many calls. There was a BZA Hearing for a one-person hair salon and the members in the audience were unanimous for approving the hair salon.

- CEMETERY:** **Any equipment Issues?** No Barney reported two burials: Virginia Sherer and Geraldine Dewitt. The new mower is here.
- ROADS:** **Any equipment Issues?** No Barney received estimate for one dead tree on Dent Road from Hardwick for \$1600. Fisher motioned to hire Hardwick to take down tree on Dent Road for \$1600. Second: Justice, all – yes, motion carried.

up to 7.5 miles of various Trenton Township roads of 18' width on a per mile unit basis. Also said bids will be received on or before June 5, 2024, at 7:15 p.m. at the Regular Meeting of the Trenton Township Trustees.

Bid blanks and specifications may be obtained from Trenton Township Trustees, Cynthia F. Walton, Fiscal Officer, 15495 Hartford Road, Sunbury, OH 43074, 740-971-3860.

Bids will be accepted on a unit price bid for Ohio Department of Transportation specifications.

All items are to be furnished and applied by the successful bidder in accordance with the Ohio Department of Transportation specifications and at the direction of the Trenton Township Trustees.

A bid bond, cashier's check, certified check or letter of credit equal to 10 percent (10%) of the unit price bid multiplied by the Engineer's estimated quantities shall be required.

A performance bond in the full amount of the bid shall be required from the successful bidder. Said bond shall be in the name of the Trenton Township Trustees within ten (10) days from the date of award.

The successful bidder shall comply with Sections 4115.03 to 4115.16 Ohio Revised Code, Prevailing Wages for Public Improvement.

Monies used to pay for this project are being provided by American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and have specific requirements that are provided in the Addendum to the contract.

The Trenton Township Trustees reserve the right to reject any and/or all bids.
