Delaware County is going to pay for one-half the bill. Almendinger asked what TRT stands for. Architect didn't submit to Berkshire Zoning but the zoning is good now. In August 141 calls with 24 of them being in Trenton Township. The Bonds have been issued and 4.5 million will be used for the building with the money left over will go back to taxpayers.
