**BSTG FIRE  
DEPARTMENT:** Fisher reported that in September there were 159 calls with 19 being in Trenton. There  
were several terminated part-time firefighters and one firefighter promoted to full-time.  
They were supposed to open the bid for the building, but Delaware County needs to  
review the plan so they may need to wait until next month for bid to be opened.

Dattilo reported that he attended the Trustees meeting and DRPC and issued one Zoning  
Certificate. There is a BZC Meeting scheduled on Monday, October 21 to consider the  
Comprehensive Plan and meet with Hollie Mattie. Ideas for Zoning Changes include:  
Solar panels on Residential Property and automatic covers or fence for swimming pools.
